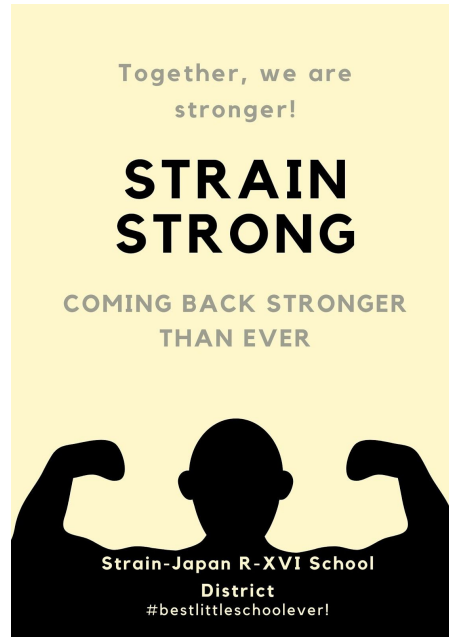


Strain-Japan R-XVI

Student and Staff safety is our number one priority as we endure this *Global Pandemic*. Many staff, community members and board members have worked diligently to ensure a safe environment for all stakeholders to return to. We look forward to getting back to the business of educating our students.

Academics:

- At this time, Strain-Japan looks forward to welcoming our students back on-site, with precautions! We will offer a virtual option provided by an outside vendor.
- Chromebooks or tablets will be available to students for distance-learning if needed.
- Google classroom will be established for every classroom.
- Students will not be allowed to share any school supplies.
- Social distancing will be utilized to the best of our ability in serving the needs of our students.
- Students will be placed in assigned seating within classroom settings.

Transportation:

- We encourage families to provide transportation to students morning and afternoon to allow for social distancing on buses.
- Buses will be sanitized between routes.
- Students will be placed in assigned seats for appropriate social distancing.
- Students will be required to wear a mask while riding the bus.

Health:

- Parents will need to self-monitor their child for fever or symptoms prior to sending them to school.

- Students who exhibit COVID-19 symptoms will be isolated from other students and staff while waiting to be picked up.
- Symptoms include, but are not limited to: fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, vomiting, feeling feverish or measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.4 F. or known close contact with a person who is lab-confirmed to have COVID-19.
- Students will be expected to follow proper handwashing guidelines and utilize hand sanitizer with a minimum of 60% alcohol when hand washing is not available. Hand sanitizer will be available at all entry and exit doors and in each classroom.
- Students with a lab-confirmed COVID-19 test will follow local health department guidelines upon return.

Recess:

- Students will have recess as in previous years and teachers are being encouraged to increase the outdoor time.
- Students will wash hands or use hand sanitizer on the way out and the way in from recess.

Food Service:

- Students will have staggered meal shifts to ensure social distancing.
- Students will not be allowed to share food. Bringing lunch is acceptable.
- Students will report to the gym upon arrival at school and will be expected to social distance prior to school and during breakfast.
- Water fountains will not be available to students. Water bottle filling stations will be available. Students will need to supply their own water bottle, labeled with their name.
- Students will be placed in assigned seating and social distance during meals.

Athletics:

- Volleyball and basketball will continue.
- Waiver of participation is required.
- Water bottles will be required by all athletes and must be labeled with the athlete's name.
- Practice equipment will be sanitized between practices

Visitors:

- No outside visitors will be allowed to go past the office foyer while the global pandemic is ongoing.
- Spectators at athletic events will be allowed with the recommendation of social distancing and wearing of masks. The district will implement a policy to aid with social distancing.

Parent Communication:

- Open House will be held in shifts according to the last name of the student.
- The district will communicate through Facebook, District website www.strainjapanschool.com and School Messenger (please sign up through the district website and parent emails. Be sure we have a current email for you.
- District forms will be online, sent through email; paper forms will not be used.
